

Classification of NSS Programme

- **Two Major Groups of NSS Activities**

- I. **NSS Regular Activities:** Under these activities the student undertake various programmes in the adopted villages, college/school camps and urban slums areas during week ends or after college hours. Duration of these services in each academic year is 120 hrs.
- II. **Special Camping Programme:** Organized during vacation camps of 07 days in adopted villages or urban slums. Local communities are also involved in this project.

Finance and Accounts

Expenditure on Regular activities: An amount of Rs. **250/-** per volunteer per annum is earmarked for expenditure on regular activities. The expenditure is shared in the ratio of **7% : 5%** between Centre and State Governments.

- Out of Rs. **250/-**, an amount of Rs. **25/-** per volunteer is spent on establishment/administration expenses at University level.
- Similarly an amount of Rs. **225/-** per volunteer is incurred on establishment at college level.
- Balance of Rs. **25/-** is spent on Programme development at grass root level.

Special Campaign Programme

- Under the special campaign programme, the camps of 07 days duration are organized during the vacations in the every year.

NSS Activities Undertaken at the University Level:

- District-wise & University wise N.S.S. Programme Officers meetings are convened at every year for planning of N.S.S. activities.
- NS.S. Advisory Board Meetings are convened **02** times every year for sanctioning the budget and planning other innovative activities.
- District-wise youth leadership camps are organized every year.
- N.S. S. Female Youth Workshop is organized for every year. This is the unique and permanent feature of this University.
- Annual Planning Meeting and Evaluation Workshop for N.S.S. Programme Officer is organized every year.
- Arts of living camps are organized in every district.
- University gives more stress on AIDS awareness programme to create the awareness amongst N.S.S. Volunteers and the community regarding to this deadly disease.
- Blood donation camps are arranged in every affiliated college having NSS Unit for every year and collected blood is given to certified blood bank. List of blood donors is prepared in every college to provide blood for emergency patients.

NSS Open Unit

- 50 Senior citizens from all walks of life are given membership of this unit in Nanded. All of them are experts in the fields of (1) Medicine (2) Law (3) Engineering (4) Arts (5) Education (6) Administration (7) Defense (8) Journalism (9) Science and Technology and (10) Music.etc.
- This unit has published a book ***Eka Naveche Prawasi*** on major religions in India with an idea of promoting communal harmony.
