CERTIFICATE COURSE IN FRENCH

PROGRAMME EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES: (WITHIN 5 YEARS OF COURSE COMPLETION)

Linguistic competence:

Progression to at least B1/B2 level proficiency in the next three to four years.

Professional domain-related intermediary proficiency in foreign language.

Professional application:

Entering professional domains and filling roles where basic knowledge of foreign language or at least bilingual proficiency is required.

Ability to successfully navigate professional transnational context using communication and intercultural skills related to the foreign language.

Cultural Knowledge and human values:

Fostering interest and tolerance for other cultures.

Generating interest in cultural production related to the foreign language such as literature, cinema and art.

PROGRAMME OUTCOMES

At the end of the Certificate Course, learners will:

PO 1: Demonstrate speaking, listening, reading, and writing skills in the target language consistent with the A1-A2 level as defined by the CERCL.

PO 2: Demonstrate an accurate understanding of basic linguistic concepts related to the target language, including the fundamentals of phonetics, syntax, semantics, basic sentence structures, as well as basic pragmatic and sociolinguistic aspects.

PO 3: Have awareness of key similarities and differences between their own cultural practices and perspectives and those of target language groups.

PO 4: Integrate the target language proficiencies and intercultural competencies to effectively perform tasks related to daily life/tourism/visit in countries using the target language and interaction with speakers of the target language.

PSO 1: Articulate basic knowledge of the countries and cultures associated with the target language.

DIPLOMA COURSE IN FRENCH

PROGRAMME EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES: (WITHIN 5 YEARS OF COURSE COMPLETION)

Linguistic competence:

Progression to at least B2/C1 level proficiency in the next three to five years.

Professional domain-related advanced proficiency in foreign language.

Capacity of creative writing in the foreign language.

Professional application:

Entering professional domains and filling roles where intermediary/advanced knowledge of foreign language or at least bilingual proficiency is required.

Ability to participate in projects where domain-specific skills in the foreign language are needed, in the role of language expert.

Ability to successfully navigate professional transnational context using communication and intercultural skills related to the foreign language.

Capacity to use linguistic competency in the foreign language for self-employment in various sectors such as education, media, translation and publishing, etc.

Critical Thinking & Research:

Fostering the capability to research, analyze and produce texts on complex social or political issues in the foreign language, including the ability to write reports.

Cultural Knowledge and human values:

Preparing students to critically analyze Francophone literatures, understand Francophone cultures, and engage with history and current affairs through film, text, and media.

Fostering capacity for holistic understanding and respect of other cultures.

PROGRAMME OUTCOMES

At the end of the Diploma Course, learners will:

PO 1: Demonstrate speaking, listening, reading, and writing skills in the target language consistent with the intermediate level of A2 (Beginners-High) to B1 (Intermediate - Mid level), in accordance with the criteria of the CECRL.

PO 2: Demonstrate an accurate understanding of linguistic concepts related to the target language, including complex sentence structures, tenses and domain specific vocabulary and structures as well as pragmatic and sociolinguistic aspects in order to interact appropriately and effectively within diverse social and cultural contexts in the target-language-speaking world.

PO 3: Develop insight into the history, culture and civilization of France and French speaking countries.

PO 4: Be able to use the target language proficiencies and intercultural competencies to carry out oral and written communication with some spontaneity on topics related to the learner and his immediate environment, professional life, society and culture.

Professional application:

Entering professional domains and filling roles where advanced knowledge of foreign language or at least bilingual proficiency is required.

Ability to participate in projects where domain-specific skills in the foreign language are needed, in the role of language expert.

Ability to successfully navigate professional transnational context using communication and intercultural skills related to the foreign language.

Capacity to use linguistic competency in the foreign language for self-employment in various sectors such as education, media, translation and interpretation, publishing, etc.

Critical Thinking & Research:

Fostering the capability to research, analyze and produce texts on complex social or political issues in the foreign language, including the ability to write reviews, argumentative essays, reports.

Cultural Knowledge and human values:

Preparing students to critically analyze Francophone literatures, understand Francophone cultures, and engage with history and current affairs through film, text, and media.

Fostering capacity for holistic understanding and respect of other cultures.

PROGRAMME OUTCOMES

At the end of the Advanced Diploma Course, learners will:

PO 1: Demonstrate speaking, listening, reading, and writing skills in the target language consistent with the B1-B2 level in accordance with the criteria of the CECRL.

PO 2: Demonstrate ability to understand (written and audio-visual) material in detail and to produce texts in writing and/or orally on a variety of professional and general topics in the target language using complex structures and styles.

PO 3: Demonstrate ability to understand, situate, analyze and discuss literature, cinema and other cultural production.

PO 4: Be able to use the target language proficiencies and intercultural competencies to interpret others' positions, opinions and needs as well as respond spontaneously in a wide range of academic and professional situations.

PROGRAMME SPECIFIC OUTCOMES

PSO 1: Acquire the linguistic competencies of the target language needed for professional communication in a variety of sectors including banking, trade, services, BPO, prompt engineering, etc.

PSO 2: Translate general, literary and technical-commercial texts (press articles, business correspondence, extracts of instruction manuals, etc.).
