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01. About the University: -

Swami Ramanand Teerth Marathwada University, Nanded has been carved out of Marathwada University, Aurangabad. Later it was renamed as Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University. The purpose of Swami Ramanand Teerth University Nanded is to establish and promote facilities for advanced, applied education and research in the jurisdiction of the university that includes four districts namely Nanded, Parbhani, Latur, and Hingoli. This university has been considered a premier institution of teaching, learning, and research. The university was established on Sept.17, 1994 under Section 4 Maharashtra of Universities Act, 1994

The Headquarter of this University is Nanded, a holy city situated on the banks of the river Godavari, the southern part of Maharashtra. This university has been named after Swami Ramanand Teerth, the Doyen of the Hyderabad Liberation Struggle and also renowned educationist, social activist and beyond that a great freedom fighter. In a short span of time, the university has been granted recognition by the UGC, New Delhi, the apex educational body of Govt. of India under 2 (f) and 12 (B) The university has been accredited with 'B' grade by the NAAC in Sept. 2010 and the 'A' grade in Jan 2015 and now B⁺⁺ in 2021.

The university has envisioned non-conventional courses using school system for the campus. At fosters teaching and learning to design initiate and promote interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary studies. The university has redesigned and developed syllabi and courses that are characterized by innovative ways of teaching, learning, and evaluation, with an emphasis on research consultancy and extension services. Right now, the university has entered into global perspective with a number of tools and products of higher education. The university imparts education mainly in the faculties of Arts, Commerce, Management Science, Social Sciences, Education, Law, Pharmacy, Ayurveda, Medical, Engineering and Technology, Library Science, and Computational Courses and Mass Media the university started Sub-Campus at Latur and Parbhani, the New Model Degree College at Hingoli and the Tribal Research Centre at Kinwat.

The efforts of the university towards excellence in higher education are being recognized by the substantial grants received from the renowned funding agencies like UGC, ICSSR, DST, DBT, CSIR, DRDO, and DAE and DEC. The university has collaboration with other premier institutions in higher education in India and abroad.

02. Center of External Education, SRTMU Nanded: -

Center of External Education is a generic term that includes range of teaching learning strategies variously described as Distance Education home study, Correspondences education or independent study. It is a highly welcome step in the direction of taking education to the doors of those who are willing to acquire higher education but being unable to continue education due to lack of resources or paucity of time. Center of External Education System fulfills the needs in education to the distant learner who has been engaged in service, business, working in the various fields and who has been a drop out of the educational process. In India, External Education Opportunists at the University levels have increased enormously. Most of the conventional universities have been running External education programs on the campus. Many new trends are putting great pressure on the conventional education systems, forcing many institutions to review their existing policies and procedures. In this light Swami Ramanand Teerth Marathawada University, Nanded took the decision to establish an External Education in 2009. The External Education was set up in the administrative building of the university.

Currently External Education department is running post graduate programmes. The department offers 11 post graduate courses like MA Marathi, Hindi, English, Urdu, Pali, Political Sciences, History, Sociology, Public administration, Economics and Master of Commerce in External Mode under Semester Pattern.

03. Objectives of the Center of External Education: -

- 1) To provide educational Facilities to:
 - i) Greater number of learners from the various age groups.
 - ii) Different sections of the society who are unable to pursue education and to bring them into the main stream.
 - iii) The female class of the society who has remained deprived because of domestic responsibilities
 - iv) All sections of the society irrespective of caste, religion gender, area of origin, Social and financial status.
 - v) Those who do not have direct access to face teaching working professionals and housewives.
- 2) To maintain flexibility on academic and administrative aspects.
- 3) To impart and provide higher education opportunities particularly to the disadvantaged segment of the society.
- 4) To offer courses along with Self Instructional Materials (SIM) contact Sessions, Counseling, facilities, Library and internet advanced technology in education through designated study centers.

04. The Advisory Committee: -

This committee has following functions.

- 1) The committee is headed by the vice-chancellor.
- 2) The committee includes the officers of the university, eminent educational it is in the jurisdiction of the university.
- 3) The committee formulates strategies and policies for academic and administrative issues pertaining to external education.
- 4) The committee maintains unity, integrity and discipline in the system.
- 5) The committee takes impartial decision for the benefit of the department.

05. Features of the Courses: -

The courses of the External Education are characterized by the following features:

- 1) There is an encouragement for greater flexibility, diversity, accessibility, mobility and innovation in education at the university level by making full use of latest scientific knowledge and new educational technology.
- 2) There is co-operation between the existing Universities.
- 3) This programme mainly focuses on the education to the adult men and women.
- 4) This is a welcome step in the direction of taking education to the doors of those who are willing to acquire higher education.
- 5) This system provides education to the unreached, residing in urban, rural and remote areas.
- 6) This system gives an opportunity to an adult learner who is willing to acquire higher education.
- 7) This system provides genuine flexibility in academic and administrative components of external mode.
- 8) The courses of external mode are designed and developed by the deans, chairman and members of board of studies of the university as per regular course
- 9) The self-instructional material for the external learner is being made available in the PDF form.
- 10) Study Centres are functioning in 90 different colleges.
- 11) Academic and administrative aspects are implemented at the centre.
- 12) The centre is connected through internet, the academic as well as administrative information is uploaded at the website.

06. The Study Centres:-

The university has identified study centers at the different colleges in the jurisdiction of the university. There are (90) post graduate study centres and under graduate study centres. The admission procedure, examination, counseling, group discussion, library reading and distribution of the digital study material, all these activities are conducted at the study centre. The study centres are allotted according to the norms of the university. The principal of the concern college works as the head of the study centre and senior most teachers work as a coordinator of the courses.

07. Registration and Eligibility: -

The study centre conduct the registration and admission process. The Center of External Education advertises admission notice for all the approved programmes. Generally, the admission process begins in the month of August every year. The admission schedule is uploaded on the website, and the admissions are conducted accordingly. The admission forms are included in the prospectus and also uploaded on the website. The students can select the nearby required study centre convenient for them. The students are required to confirm his/her eligibility as per admission eligibility criteria. The students are also required to submit the duly filled application form along with the necessary attested photo copies of each supporting document and required fee at the study centre. Filling the examination form, examination fee, hall tickets, and all such activities will be conducted at the study centre. The students are required to pay the fee as per the university schedule. The late fee facility is also made available by the centre. All the rules and regulations regarding admissions, eligibility criteria, admission fee, and examination fee are provided in the prospectus.

Eligibility Criteria and General Rules for Admission

A male or female candidate residing in India or abroad who has completed 20 years of his/her age is qualified for admission to the course conducted by the Center of External Education. The External learner is an adult person who is already engaged in service, business and any occupation and who has been deprived of his education.

“The degree should be completed within five years.”

(A) General Rules and Eligibility Criteria for PG Courses: -

- The candidate who has completed the UG degree privately or regularly from any recognized universities eligible to take admission.
- A candidate with his/her UG from any branch can be admitted to any PG programme except languages.

- A candidate who has acquired any pg degree from the recognized universities is also eligible to appear pg in another discipline.
- A candidate who wants to appear as the pg programmer privately is also eligible for the approved pg courses of this university.
- There is no maximum age limit for admission.
- A candidate who has acquitted a PG degree from any discipline from other university can appear for the courses in humanities, social sciences and commerce and management run by external education department.
- There is no need for a gap certificate during admission.
- There is no restriction on the submission of migration certificate.
- A candidate can avail themselves of dual degree system in one academic year.
- The degree from external education of this university is considered equal to conventional degrees for the central and state govt, competitive examination and its various sectors.
- A candidate is not required to produce original T.C. marksmemo or caste certificate during the admission of any course.
- A medium of language for writing answer sheets during the examination will be Marathi, Hindi or English.
- A candidate who wants to improve his educational standard for getting B+ has to pay double amount of the fee.
- The learners are required to receive and study the self-learning material in PDF form prepared by the study centre.
- It is mandatory for the study centres to conduct counseling sessions of the students as per this schedule.
- The students are required to submit a project report having **120+30** marks.
- Every year, there will be inspection and assessment of the academic and administrative programmes conducted by the study centres.
- The Exam dates will be as per regular exams of the university.
- There will be no change in exam dates for any reason.

12. Learning Methodology:

The learner of the open and external education is an adult learner, who is engaged in service or business and who is unable to attend college and university regular classes due to her job, service and profession. These learners are unable to give sufficient time like the regular students in conventional system. The distant learners of this university are working people, house wife learners.

- Counseling, guidance of the expert in the contact session.
- Group discussion, presentation, question bank.

13. Syllabus of External Education is same as the regular syllabus of the university.

14. Contact Sessions and Counseling: -

The Co-ordinator of the study centre in consultation with the Head/Principal should conduct contact sessions courses wise and paper-wise. The Study Centers are expected to send the copy of the contact session time table to the head office and also expected to maintain attendance of the student, staff accordingly. The study centre must be well equipped with furniture, electricity, water supply, seating arrangement library, computer and internet and these facilities should be provided for the learners. The contact sessions must be conducted during the vacation, on holiday and after office hours. The subject-wise, period-wise and teacher-wise time table should be prepared. The counselors are not expected to teach and arrange lectures, but they are expected to provide discussion, two-way communication on the points they would be discussing. The teacher and learners should have interaction based on the points delivered.
