:: EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION FOR TEACHING POSTS:-

For the Disciplines of Arts, Commerce, Humanities, Education, Social Sciences, Sciences, Languages, Physical Education, and Journalism & Mass Communication.

I. Assistant Professor in Universities

Eligibility: (A or B):

A. 1) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university. Government Resolution No.: Misc-2018/C.R.56/18/UNI-1 Page 6 of 60

2) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil. /Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SET :

Provided the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances / Bye-laws / Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/ SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in regular mode only;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal; and
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers, based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/ seminars, sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC/ICSSR/CSIR or any similar agency.

Note:

- 1) The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (academic affairs) of the University concerned.
- 2) NET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/ SET is not conducted. However, Ph.D. degree shall remain the minimum eligibility for appointment of Assistant Professor in such disciplines.

B.

The Ph.D. degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following:

- (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) ;
- (ii) The Times Higher Education (THE) or
- (iii) The Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

* **Candidates having the following qualifications will be given preference for Geo-Informatics course:**
M.Sc. /M.A./ Ph.D. in Geo-informatics OR Post Graduate Diploma in Geo-Informatics OR M.Tech.in Geo-informatics.

* **P.G.+ Ph.D/SET/NET in social science Candidate having the following qualification will be**

given preference for Women's Studies course: P.G. Diploma in Women's Studies, P.G.in Women's Studies, Ph.D. in Women's Studies and NET in Women's Studies.

*** Candidates having the following qualifications will be given preference for PGDMLT course:**

M.Sc. in Microbiology/Biotechnology/Chemistry /Zoology with PGDMLT. Candidates with teaching experience in PGDMLT preferred.

*** B.Sc. MLT Programme Required Educational qualification:** M.Sc. in Medical Laboratory Technology/or Medical Laboratory Science / Biochemistry (Allied Health Care) / Microbiology (Allied Health Care) / Biomedical Science / Biochemistry with P.G.D.M.L.T. / Microbiology with P.G.D.M.L.T.

*** Candidates having the qualifications will be given preference for Commerce/Business**

Administration:- Finance, Accountancy for M.B.A. and M.Com. Courses.

*** PGDDM Required Educational qualification:-** MBA Disaster / PGDDM

*** PGDGC Required Educational qualification:-** M.A. Psychology, or M.A. Guidance & Counselling, or MSW (With Counselling Experience) and eligibility as per UGC regulations (SET / NET or Ph.D.)

*** Hospitality Studies Essential and desirable Educational Qualification:-** Post Graduate in Hospitality /Tourism or MBA from a recognized University/Institute.

And(+)

Full Time Degree/Full Time three years Diploma in Hotel Administration / Hospitality Management/ Hotel Management / Hospitality Administration/ Culinary Arts/Culinary Science with minimum of 55 % marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade from :

- (i) NCHMCT OR NCHMCT affiliated institute. **OR**
- (II) An institute approved by AICTE. **OR**
- (III) An institute approved by the State Board of Technical Education. **OR**
- (IV) An institute affiliated to University duly recognized by UGC. **OR**
- (v) Central/State/Deemed to be University recognized by UGC. **OR**
- (vi) Equivalent degree/ diploma of foreign university/ institution recognized by AIU.

*** Diploma in Cyber Law:-** Post Graduation in Law Or Cyber Law with B+ Grade along with PG Diploma in Cyber Law is essential. NET or Ph.D. in Concern Subject preferred

*** Diploma in GST :-** Post Graduation in Commerce with B+ Grade along with PG Diploma in GST is essential. NET or Ph. D in Concern Subject preferred

II. Assistant Professor in Universities: (For the Disciplines of Fine and Performing Arts)

Eligibility (A or B):

A.

i) Master's Degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in the relevant subject or an equivalent degree from an Indian/foreign University.

ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be.

Provided further, candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/ Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges /Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:

- a) Ph.D. degree has been awarded to the candidate in a regular mode
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate had been conducted;
- d) Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which, at least one is in a refereed journal; and
- e) The candidate has presented at least two research papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/ seminars supported/funded/sponsored by the UGC/AICTE/ICSSR or any other similar agency.

Note 1: The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

Note 2: The clearance of NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC (like SLET/SET).

OR

B. A traditional or a professional artist with highly commendable professional achievement in the subject concerned having a Bachelor's degree, who has:

- i) studied under a noted/reputed traditional Master(s)/Artist(s)
- ii) Has been 'A' grade artist of AIR/Doordarshan;
- iii) Has the ability to explain, with logical reasoning the subject concerned; and
- iv) Has adequate knowledge to teach theory with illustrations in the discipline concerned.

III. Assistant Professor in Universities (For the Disciplines of Computer Science) Eligibility:

1. BE / B Tech and ME / M Tech in relevant subject with first class or equivalent either in BE B Tech or ME /M Tech; **or**
BE /B Tech and MCA with first class or equivalent either in BE / B Tech or MCA; **or**
MCA with first class or equivalent either with two years relevant experience

IV. (For the Disciplines of Management)

i. Essential:

1. First Class Masters Degree in Business Management/Administration/ in a relevant management related discipline or first class in two year full time PGDM declared equivalent by AIU/ accredited by the AICTE / UGC.

OR

2. First Class Graduate and Professionally Qualified Chartered Accountant/Cost and Works Accountant/ Company Secretary of the concerned statutory bodies.

Desirable

- i. Teaching research, industrial and/ or professional experience in a reputed organization;
- ii. Papers presented at Conference and /or published in referred journals.

V. (For the Disciplines of MCA)

Essential: B.E. / B.Tech. / B.S. and M.E. / M.Tech. / M.S. or Integrated M.Tech. in relevant branch with First Class or equivalent in any one of the degrees.

OR

B. E., B. Tech. and MCA with First Class or equivalent in any one of the two degrees.

OR

Graduation of three years' duration with Mathematics as a compulsory subject and MCA with First Class or equivalent with 2 years of relevant experience after acquiring degree of MCA.

:: IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS ::

1. A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the graduate and master's level for the Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Differently-abled (Physically and visually differently-abled) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to teaching positions. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.
2. University reserves the rights to reduce or increase the number of posts & to fill up or not to fill up any of the advertised posts, without assigning any reasons.
3. University reserves the rights to decide criteria / procedure for short listing of the candidates.
4. As per provision laid down in State Govt. Notification No. SRV.2000 / CR (17/ 2000) / XII dated 28th March, 2005 issued by General Administration Department, Mantralaya, Mumbai, candidates must submit the prescribed declaration of the small family as one of the essential qualifications for recruitment, in the prescribed proforma with Application Form, as Declaration FORM-A.
5. A candidate furnishing incorrect or false information shall stand disqualified at any stage.
6. Mere possession of minimum qualifications does not confer any right to be appeared for interview and / or selection.
7. No TA / DA will be paid either for attending the interview or for joining the post.
8. The University shall not be held responsible for postponement or cancellation of scheduled interviews for any unforeseen / unavoidable reasons.
9. Canvassing in any form, directly or indirectly, will disqualify the candidate immediately.
10. Candidate should submit attested one set of copies of all the documents/certificates at the time of interview.
