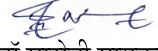

Introduction

TSA/TSA Hybrid is an attempt for disbursement of funds under Central Sector Schemes for more effective cash management and with an aim of achieving the goal of “Just-in-time” fund flow from the Central Ministries/Departments/Central Nodal Agencies to Autonomous Bodies/Sub-Agencies and down the line agencies through an integrated network of PFMS, RBI and Scheduled Commercial Banks.

The new **Agency Program** and **Agency Project-wise Implementation** functionality in **TSA/TSA Hybrid** enables Ministries, CNAs, Agencies, and Sub-Agencies to monitor fund flow, expenditure, and utilization at the program and project levels under a scheme. Through this feature, the CNA can give assignments Agency Program-wise and Agency Project-wise to its mapped sub-agencies, with each Agency Project forming part of an Agency Program. To facilitate program/project-based fund management, parent agencies must map sub-agencies to the relevant Agency Programs and Agency Projects using the **Agency Program and Agency Project-wise Mapping** menu.

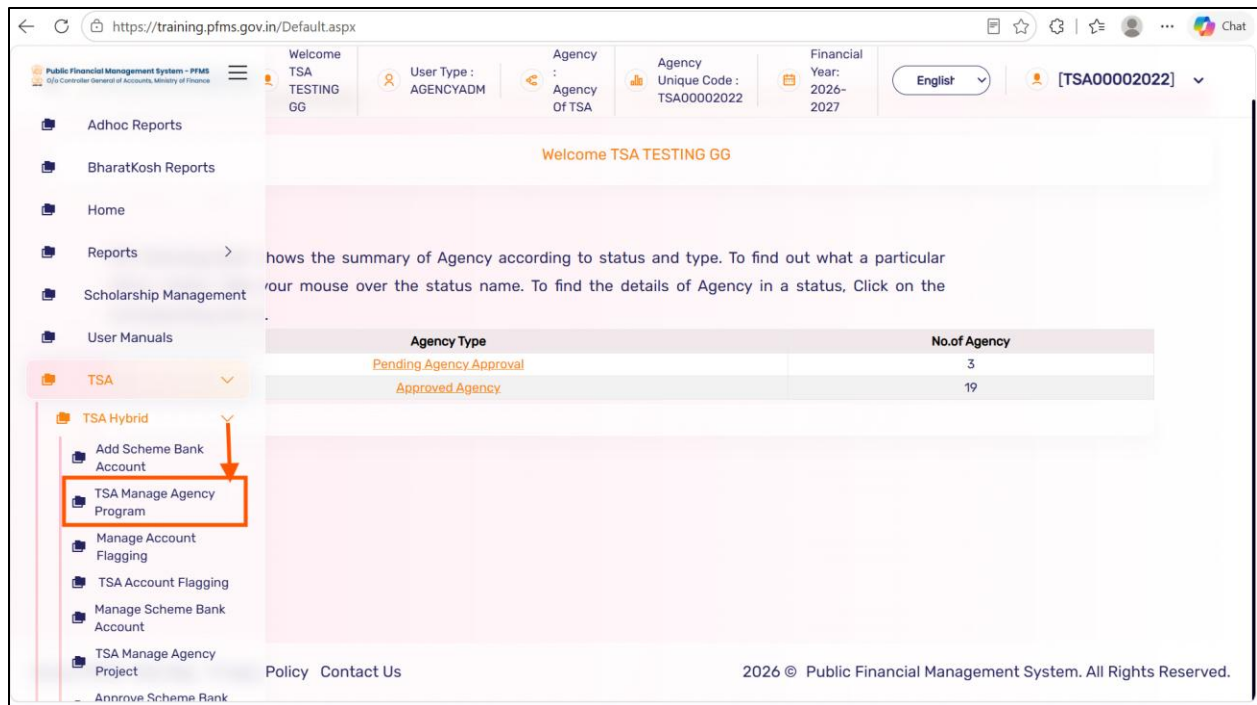

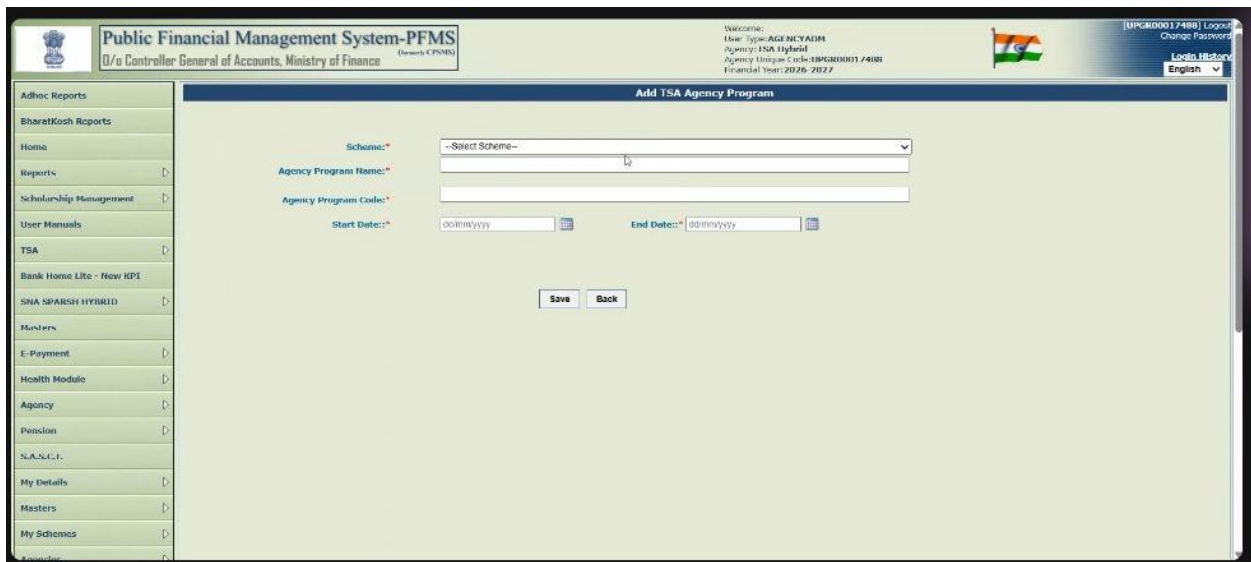

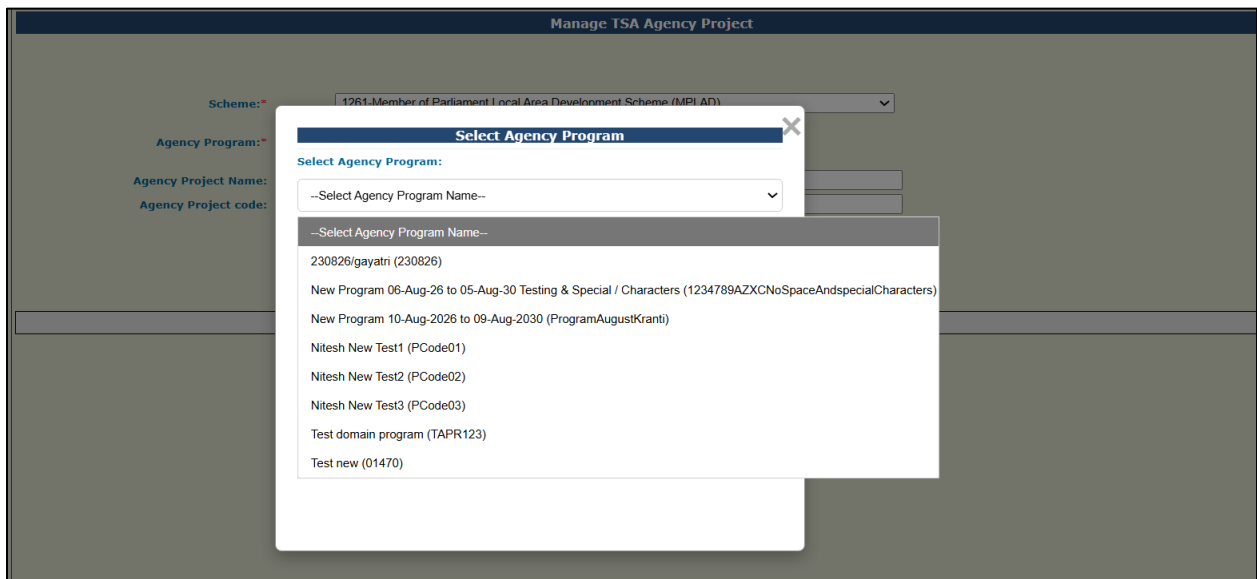

E. Limit Allocation by Funding Agency/ CNA agency admin.

 In Limit Allocation Functionality, we have introduced an enhancement, **Limits - New Limit / Update Limit**, for user ease and better efficiency of the functionality.

The Agency Admin user will select **New Limit** when they wish to allocate a fresh limit to the agencies mapped with them. Once the limits are assigned to any agency, e.g. Agency A1, Agency A1 will disappear from the list. Only the agencies to whom limits have not yet been allocated will remain visible. Similarly, the user will select **Update Limit** when they wish to update(add/withdraw/delete) the already allocated limits.

Limit Allocation For:

- **Limit Allocation for Self** (Funding Agency acting as Recipient Agency)
The CNA will register the RBI Account to act as the Funding Agency and flag the Commercial Bank Savings Account as TSA Hybrid to act as the Recipient Agency. Thereafter, it can assign a drawing limit to itself from RBI Account to TSA Hybrid and further allocate limits from TSA Hybrid Account to its child agencies for raising claims. For limit allocation to self, the Agency Admin user must select the RBI Account as the bank account for limit allocation.
- **Limit Allocation to Child Agencies**
Once the self-allocation is carried out, Funding/Recipient Agency Admin User will select the select the Scheduled Commercial Bank Account Number when selecting the Bank Account Number. Then User can respectively allocate the limits to its child agencies mapped.
In case the savings accounts are operated by the child agencies, funding agency will directly allocate the limits from its RBI Account to the savings accounts of the child agencies.

- Total Limit of Parent agency will be equal to the Assignment amount received under the selected sanction.
- Expenditure limit = Amount which Parent Agency intends to keep for their own expenditure.
- Limit for Child Agencies = Difference of Parent Agency total limit and Parent Agency expenditure limit
- Balance expenditure limit = Balance left after expenditure by Parent Agency
- Balance Child's Limit = Difference of child agency limit and allocated amount to child agency against the claim raised
- Total expenses- Total expenses are expenses done by parent agency /Child Agency.

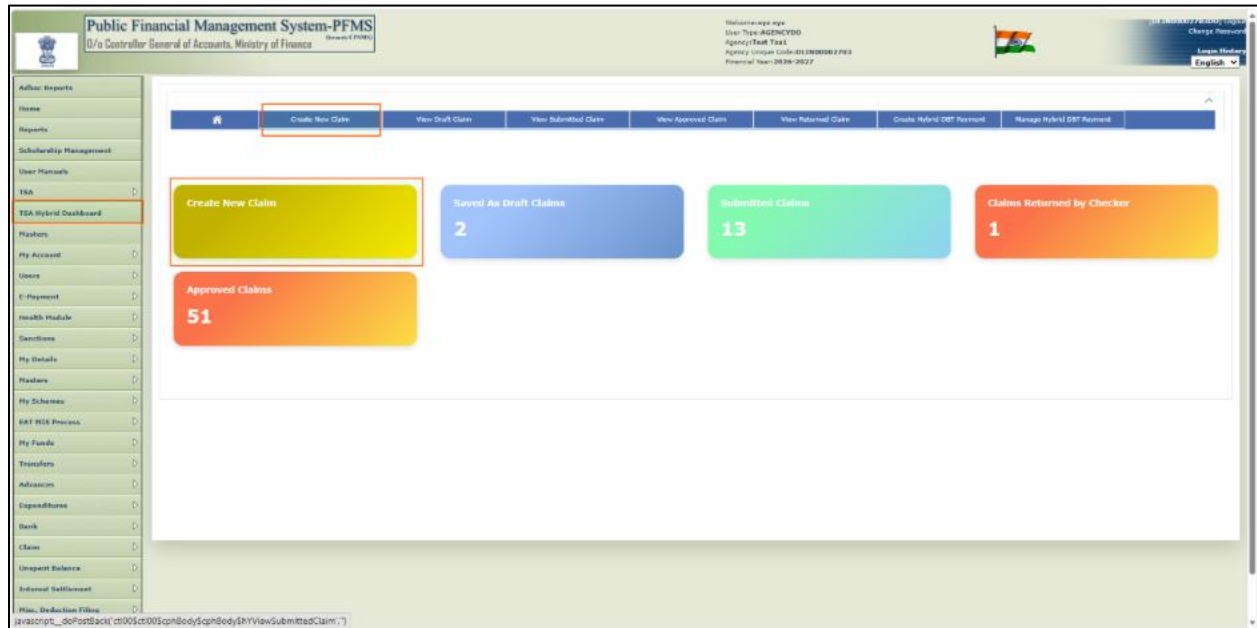
